

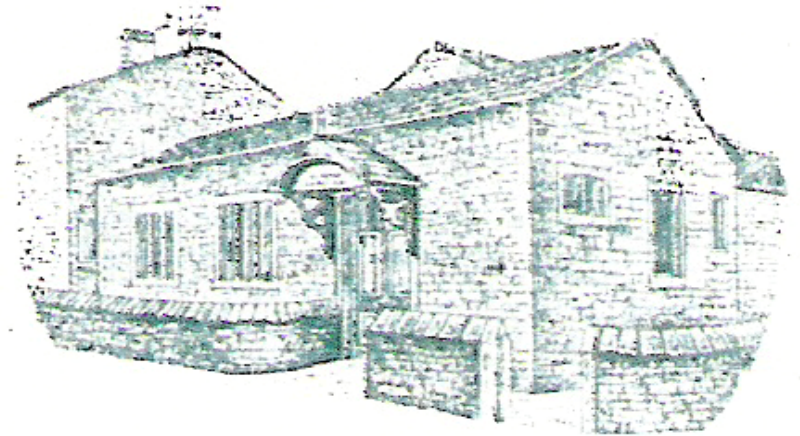

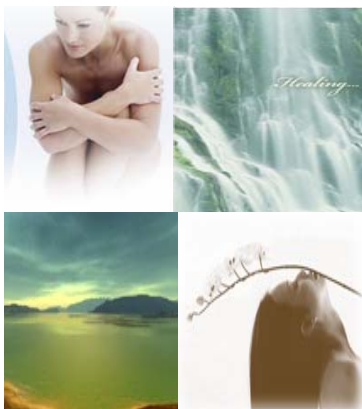

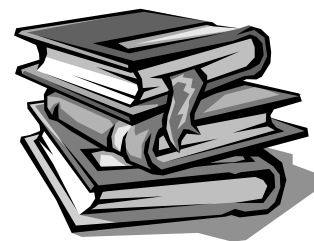
There are many ways in which you can support and help the Village Hall, with varying levels of commitment. Give as little or as much as you like. Below are just a few examples

Dear Neighbour

The roof at the front of the hall has holes in it and this is threatening its architectural heritage – the original schoolhouse dating back to the 19th century. This will affect the long-term sustainability of the hall and it needs to be repaired as a matter of urgency.

The village hall is a community facility that does not receive direct council funding. As a registered charity the Hall's Management Committee raises all necessary funds to maintain the hall. We are asking local residents, businesses and other funding partners to raise £40,000 to repair the roof. We are asking for donations of £5 per slate.
